The new facilities opened on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February and are part of a programme of improvements by not-for-profit organisation Circadian Trust, which runs the leisure centres in South Gloucestershire in partnership with South Gloucestershire Council.

Over the next few weeks, the Centre will be relocating its two dance studios to a new refurbished room with sprung floor and a dedicated Spin Studio, whilst work has already begun to transform the café which will offer a wider range of food and drink.

Andy Robinson, Centre Manager said, "As a not for profit organisation, we can continue to reinvest money back into Active Centres across the region which means offering our customers the best and most advanced health and fitness space and equipment."

"It also means we can respond to changing customer demands. Indoor cycling, for instance, is becoming increasingly popular which is why we have created the new cycling studio and invested in more bikes. There are now a total of 30 studio cycles."
